Executive Director's Report: Ben Popp

- Ben has been nominated to Governor's Council on Tourism.
- Birkie has received a \$60,000 grant from the Huelsmann Foundation for the Kortelopet that will be used to build infrastructure for the start venue at OO.
- Our staff has started to build out contingencies for finishing the Birkie at several potential spots if we don't have good snow on the full trail.
- Right now there is plenty of ice on Hayward Lake, and we have snow piled up to go on the lake but there is no natural snow there.
- We will be meeting with the DOT about the crossing at Highway 77. We have preliminary plans for an overpass that would cost about \$210, 000, while estimates for a tunnel under 77 would be \$509, 000.
