Early in my career I spent several years as the Chairperson of the Burnett County Historical Society during the time period where the historical site Forts Folle Avoine was recreated.

Finally, I was one of the lead attorneys for Wisconsin Chippewa Off-Reservation Hunting Fishing and Gathering case resulting in a 5 to 4 decision in favor of the Tribes in the United States Supreme Court. Other projects included real estate transaction, land use planning and governmental affairs.

Over the past 40 years I have supported local ski organizations including the Cumberland Area Ski Trails Association and their Timberland Hills course and the ski facilities at Nine Mile Forest Recreation area outside of Wausau, Wisconsin. It is the local ski organization that provide the life blood of the Birkie.
