

RACE DAY BAG DROP/PICKUP

There is only one drop zone in the start area.

- Only Birkie gear bags and plastic bags received at bib pick-up will be accepted
- · Absolutely no skis, poles, or other bags will be accepted
- If using a Birkie gear bag, your bib number must be displayed in the plastic sleeve at the top of the bag
- Do not overfill your bag or place items in the outside pockets
- · Close, buckle, or tie your bag before dropping it off
- Once your bag is dropped it cannot be retrieved until it arrives in the recovery zone

Picking up your bag

- All bags will be transported to the Recovery Zone in downtown Hayward
- The American Birkebeiner Ski Foundation is not responsible for lost or stolen items
- You must present a bib to retrieve your gear bag, you may send someone to pick your bag up for you

AID STATIONS – WHAT TO EXPECT

- **Fuel Up!** Water, GU energy & hydration and food options at the aid stations. Find out exactly what will be there at **birkie.com**.
- **Trash Penalty!** If you throw trash anywhere along the trail, you may receive a 15 minute time penalty added to your official finish time
 - Report trash violations by emailing birkie@birkie.com
 - There will be a TerraCycle collection bin at each aid station for energy gel & bar packaging disposal
- Wax: SWIX kick wax is available at each aid station
- Poles: SWIX replacement poles are available at each aid station, ask a volunteer for help. After the race, return the loaned pole to Lost & Found.

- Each aid station is equipped with a shelter and staffed by medical professionals
- The course is continually patrolled by members of the National Ski Patrol





DROPPING OUT OR MISSING THE CUT-OFF TIME

- It is imperative that we know if a skier drops out!
- Skiers who drop out must report to an Aid Station Chief or Birkie Medical Chief. Transport to the finish zone will be provided.
- Skiers who miss a cut-off time will be transported to the finish zone

FINISH TIMES

Racers are expected to finish on Main Street from 12pm-5pm

FINISH ZONE

Medical Care

 A team of trained medical professionals from Hayward Area Memorial Hospital will be serving those in need of assistance in the Finish Zone

Finisher Medals and Pins

- Completing the American Birkebeiner Open Track or Kortelopet Open Track counts toward your decade award
- All finishers will receive a commemorative medal or pin indicating the total number of races completed (2023 included)
- Proceed toward the sign and aisle that corresponds to the year sticker affixed to your bib; this will ensure you receive the correct award
- Decade awards can be picked up at the Birkie Store in the celebration zone during store hours
- If you can't pick up your award in person, you may request that it be shipped to you, at your expense, until March 31, 2023. Visit Birkie.com and complete the necessary form to ship your award.

Skiers can reunite with spectators in the Recovery Zone

Birkie Gear Bag & Plastic Bag Pick-Up

- You must have your bib with you to claim your Birkie gear bag or plastic bag
- Go to the sign indicating your wave number, show the volunteer your bib number, and they'll retrieve your Birkie gear bag or plastic drop bag
- You must present a bib to retrieve your gear bag, you may send someone to pick your bag up for you

Changing Area

Changing space only, there are no showers available

Finisher Meal

- Head to the Celebration Zone for your finisher meal
- Athletic Brewing non-alcoholic beer

FINISH LINE VIDEO

Create a shout-out video for your friends or family skiing an **Open Track Event!**

- Create your very own shout-out video that will be played as athletes cross the finish line on Main Street in Hayward!
- When the participant crosses the timing system at the finish line prior to the video board it will trigger their video
- Because there may be many participants with submitted videos passing the board simultaneously, it may not be possible to show everyone's video
- Suggested video length is between 5 to 10 seconds long. This gives long enough to get your participant's attention, but not too long that other videos do not have time to play.
- Video submissions will be accepted until Tuesday, February 21st, at 7pm CST



GETTING TO THE START - KORTELOPET

- · All participants and spectators must bus from the Birkie Ridge lot
- Birkie Ridge to Start: 8am-12:30pm
- Recovery Zone back to Birkie Ridge: 12:30pm-5:30pm

TIMING YOUR ARRIVAL

- Allow plenty of drive time to get to skier parking lots due to traffic on race day
- Allow at least 30 minutes to park and board a bus once you arrive at Birkie Ridge. Time on the bus will be 20-30 minutes.
- Plan to arrive at the start at least 30 minutes prior to your gate 3 entry time which will allow time to walk to the start area, bag drop, portable bathroom use, warm-up, etc.
- If you miss your start, you will be allowed to start in the next available wave of the same technique

RACE DAY BAG DROP/PICKUP

Bag drop is arranged by wave

Classic and skate waves drop in the same location

- Only Birkie gear bags and plastic bags received at bib pick-up accepted
- Absolutely no skis, poles, or other bags will be accepted
- If using a Birkie gear bag, your bib number must be displayed in the plastic sleeve at the top of the bag
- Do not overfill your bag or place items in the exterior pockets
- Close, buckle, or tie your bag before dropping it off
- Once your bag is dropped it cannot be retrieved until it arrives in the recovery zone

Picking up your bag

- · All bags will be transported to the Recovery Zone in downtown Hayward






Wednesday Open Track Map







Map of Downtown Hayward
