

If you are registered for Wed. Open Track you MUST ski on Wednesday. No transfers allowed to events on other days.

OPEN TRACK BIB PICKUP

- Tuesday, 4pm-7pm at the Celebration Tent
- Wednesday, 6:30am-10:00am at the Celebration Tent
- There will not be bibs available at the start area of Open Track events

Credentials Required for Bib Pick-Up

- You must bring a PHOTO ID to pick up your bib
- Youth without a photo ID will be verified by their parent/guardian
- You may pick up a bib for another skier, only if you are also picking up your own bib. You must have a paper or electronic copy of the other skier(s) bib confirmation email(s), copy of photo ID, and signed authorization
- Entries are non-transferable between individuals

RACE DAY BAG DROP/PICKUP

There is only one drop zone in the start area

- Only Birkie gear bags and plastic gear bags received at bib pick-up will be accepted
- Absolutely no skis, poles, or other bags will be accepted
- Your bib number must be prominently displayed on your gear bag
- Do not overfill your bag or place items in the outside pockets
- Close, buckle, or tie your bag before dropping it off

Picking up your bag

- All bags will be transported to the Recovery Zone in downtown Hayward
- You must present a bib to retrieve your gear bag, you may send someone to pick your bag up for you
- The American Birkebeiner Ski Foundation is not responsible for lost or stolen items










AID STATIONS





- **Trash Penalty!** Trash disposal available at every aid station on course in labeled bins. If you throw trash anywhere along the trail, you may receive a 15 minute time penalty added to your official finish time
 - Report trash violations by emailing birkie@birkie.com
- Wax: SWIX kick wax is available at each aid station
- **Poles:** SWIX replacement poles are available at each aid station
- After the race, return the pole at the finish line

AID STATION MEDICAL CARE

 Each aid station is equipped with a shelter and staffed by medical professionals - The course is also monitored by members of the National Ski Patrol

DROPPING OUT OR MISSING THE CUT-OFF TIME

- It is imperative that we know if a skier drops out!
- Skiers who drop out must report to a Birkie Chief at an aid station or Finish Line
- Transport to the finish line will be provided for those who are unable to continue or missed the cut off time at aid stations

FINISH TIMES

Racers are expected to finish on Main Street from 11am-5pm.





FINISH ZONE Medical Care

Finisher Medals and Pins

- All finishers will receive a commemorative medal or pin indicating the total number of races completed (2025 included) and Salomon ski ties
- Completing the American Birkebeiner Open Track or Kortelopet Open Track counts toward your decade award
- Decade awards can be picked up at the Birkie Store in the Celebration Zone during store hours see page 38.
- If you can't pick up your award in person, you may request that it be shipped to you, at your expense, until March 31, 2025. Visit Birkie .com and complete the necessary form to ship your award.



- Fuel Up! Water, UnTapped Fuel & Hydration and other food options
- **Trash Penalty!** If you are throw trash outside the aid station, you may receive a 15 minute time penalty added to your official finish time
 - Report trash violations by emailing birkie@birkie.com



Barnebirkie & Jr. Birkie Map












Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday Race Course Maps




